MEMBERS TRAVELLING OVERSEAS

When travelling overseas, members will be covered for Death and Disablement benefits. However, where on the day before they leave Australia, the country they are travelling is the subject of an Australian Government travel advisory notice advising against all travel, they will not be insured.

If a member travels against this advice which is later downgraded, they will only be covered from the date the Australian Government travel advisory changes from advising against all travel.

LEAVE WITHOUT PAY

Members commencing leave without pay ie maternity, paternity, study are still covered for Death and Disablement benefits for up to 12 months.

However this is subject to their employer approving the leave and advising Rei Super in writing. This can be either by email, updating the contribution return or using the Change of Member Details advice available in the Forms section of the website www.reisuper.com.au
